What is the proposed Piambong Wind Farm?

Wind energy projects harness an abundant natural resource to generate clean energy. The Piambong region is one of the best wind resource areas in NSW and is within the Central-West Orana Renewable Energy Zone. Vestas is developing a wind farm project at Piambong, with between 75-85 turbines.



Estimated investment is more than \$1 billion in the Central West New South Wales region.



Up to 400 new construction jobs over a 2.5 year construction period and 15 long-term service jobs to be based in the local area.



Up to 550 MW of new renewable energy capacity to help achieve the state's renewable energy goals and assist with Australia's energy transition.



Generating enough clean, affordable energy to power approximately 300,000 average NSW homes every year.



Up to 1.6 million tonnes of CO₂ equivalent emissions avoided each year.

Engagement, transparency and benefit-sharing with the local community are critical to a successful project.

The planning process

Piambong Wind Farm is currently in the final stages of submitting an updated Scoping Report, which details the results of our early engagement and preliminary studies. The Scoping Report will be lodged with the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE), which will instruct Vestas about the information that needs to be included in the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).

Piambong Wind Farm aims to commence the EIS at the end of 2023 and complete it in 2025. The EIS will then be lodged with DPE, which will place the EIS on public exhibition for a minimum of 28 days. During the exhibition period, all community members, stakeholders and government agencies will be encouraged to make a submission.
